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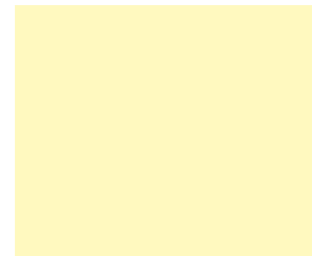
Vivu Reaches No. 1 on World Music Charts Europe for August 2026
